Sunnah's of Eid-ul-Fitr:

- Waking up early in the morning
- Bathing and wearing the best clothes
- Wear perfume
- Eat something sweet
- Showing up to Eid prayer early
- Arrive at Eid prayer location by one route and leave by another
- Recite the following on the way to, and way from Eid prayer:
"Allahu Akbar, Allahu Akbar, Laa ilaaha illallahu Wallahu Akbar, Allahu Akbar, Wa lillahil Hamd" (Translation: Allah is the greatest, He is the greatest. There is no god except Allah. He is the greatest. All praises and thanks are for Him)
- Giving Fitra before Eid prayer.

The month of Shawwal:

It is commendable to keep six fasts in the month of Shawwal. The Prophet (S.A.W.) said: "Whoever completes the fasts of Ramadan, then adds to them the fast of six days in the month of Shawwal, it will carry the reward of fasting for the whole year." (Sahih Muslim). Muslims should take the opportunity of acquiring such an enormous reward from Allah. It is more preferable to start these fasts from the 2nd of Shawwal and keep fasting up to the 7th of it. However, if they are kept in other days it is hoped that the requirement of the above hadith may also be fulfilled.
